



Naperville Woman's Club 51st Annual Juried Fine Art Fair

The NWC proudly announces our 51st Annual Fine Art Fair to be held July 10-11, 2010 on the grounds of Naper Settlement, a 19th Century Museum Village, located at 523 S. Webster Street, 1 block south of the Naperville Riverwalk. Hours are 10am to 5pm Saturday and Sunday. There is no admission charge to the Fine Art Fair or to the historic village.

100 artists' spaces available • Over \$2,500 in Cash Awards

Eligible Media

Participation is open to artists working in painting, drawing, fiber art, graphics, mixed media, photography, jewelry, sculpture, ceramics, metal, glass and wood. High quality 2D reproductions in signed and numbered, limited editions are allowed. Prints must be of original work produced by the artist and clearly labeled as a reproduction. This is restricted to one flip bin. Only artists accepted in the jewelry category may display and sell jewelry. If an artist is displaying in 2 mediums (example fused glass artwork and selling earrings), you must jury in both the Glass category and the jewelry category and be accepted in both. Additional jury fees apply.

Artist Amenities

- Booth spaces are a generous 12' X 11' on the beautiful grounds of Naper Settlement.
- All booths are located on grass.
- Every booth is accessible by car making for easy setup.
- Storage behind booths is allowed if kept neat and to a minimum.
- Setup Friday 4:30pm to dark or Saturday 7:30 to 9:30am.
- Convenient, free parking for artists.
- Complimentary continental breakfast both mornings.
- Saturday evening Artists Reception 5:30 to 7pm. (Attendance is encouraged.)
- Up to 100 event postcards.

Naper Settlement grounds are enclosed but not locked. Artists are responsible for the safety, and security of their work and property. Your basic set up may be left Friday and Saturday nights at your own risk. Please review the liability waiver.

Application Instructions

1. Submit five slides, four of your current work and one of your booth display in standard 2"x2" plastic mounts (**NO THICK MOUNTS**) in a protective plastic slide sleeve. **Label each slide with your name, medium, and place a red dot in the lower left corner. Number each slide in lower right corner to correspond with your slide descriptions on the back of this form.** (See diagram on back)
2. Complete and sign the application.
3. Send 2 checks, payable to: Naperville Woman's Club.
 - \$30 for the non-refundable jury fee, \$40 after 2/15/10
 - \$260 for the booth fee (to be cashed upon acceptance).
4. SASE for the return of slides.

Applications must be postmarked by February 14, 2010.

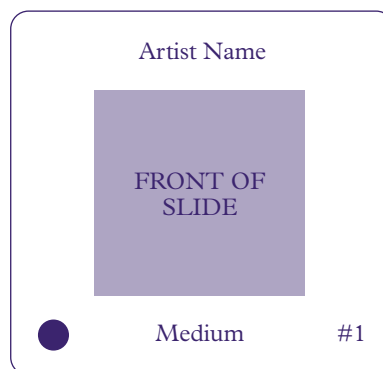
Notification of acceptance will be sent by March 30.

Written notice of cancellation must be made by June 1

to Roxanne in order to receive a booth fee refund

minus a \$25 handling fee.

Jury Process

The jury will view each artist's set of 5 slides simultaneously. The work you exhibit must be consistent with your slides. Please pay attention to your booth slide. It should be void of persons or signs with names. The booth slide may be used as a deciding factor if two artists are tied. The director may be involved in artist selection after the jury process due to unexpected circumstances.
